Shield Winner- The Club with the best 3 aggregate team scores

Includes ball competition

To Qualify

- Each club must run a 2BBB STABLEFORD competition day prior in order to select a club team.
- The best five (5) pairs over the field on the designated club day are selected for the club team

Gwen Thompson Memorial Shield

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- Teams are to consist of two players.
- The game is a 2BBB STABLEFORD game with one score from each pair to count on each hole.
- A qualifying round will be held at club level and the top five (5) pairs will represent their club in the Gwen Thompson Shield.
- Each pair must consist of members of the same club.
- Players qualifying to represent their club must be members of that club throughout the tournament.
- Once a player has qualified, she is no longer eligible to enter the competition at another club.
- In the event of a tie the Golf NSW count back system will be used.
- If a pair is unable to play, the next qualifying pair may play. If one player is unable to play, she can be replaced, by a similar handicapped player.
- The club with the best aggregate score of three (3) teams will be the winner of the Gwen Thompson Memorial Shield.
- In the event of a draw there will be a count back on the scores of the best pairs at the district final. If still a draw then a count back will be done on the scores of the second best pairs, then the number of three pairs then number four pairs. If still no result a draw will be declared.

Trophies:

There will be an overall winning team trophy and all members of the winning Gwen Thompson Shield team will receive a trophy.

Maximum daily handicap of 45

About Gwen Thompson Memorial Shield

The Gwen Thompson Memorial Shield was introduced by the district in 1988 to celebrate the Bi-Centenary. It was named in honour of Gwen Thompson, an early secretary of the District. It was initially a 3BBB but is now a 2BBB with 5 teams per club.
