To be played in accord with the Rules of Golf, the local rules of Kooindah Waters Golf Club (players are responsible to ensure they have read and understand the local rules of Kooindah Waters Golf Club) and the following:

1. The event is to be played in two (2) divisions. Divisions are based on handicaps as determined in accordance with the world Golf Handicap System – 2 Man Ambrose, the lowest marker playing off 35% of his handicap, the higher marker playing off 15% off his handicap e.g. player #1 handicap 2, player #2 handicap 36. Player #1 adjusted handicap 0.7 and player #2 adjusted handicap 5.4 therefore aggregate handicap 6.1.

Divisions based on percentages will be determined once entries close.

There will be two (2) prizes in each Division for both gross and nett scores. The gross event shall take precedence. Prizes will be presented at the District Presentation Night at Everglades on 24 November 2023.

2. Pairings will be provided with a score card which <u>MUST</u> be used. Scores returned electronically will not be accepted.

On completion of the round the card <u>MUST</u> be returned to the CCDGA representative in the Clubhouse precincts.

3. Tee shots of each player must be used on at least six (6) holes. The score card must reflect whose tee shot was used on each hole.

The owner of the selected ball must play it as it lies. Other than on the putting green the other ball to be dropped within one (1) club length of the chosen ball no nearer to the hole.

Subsequent shots must be played from the same conditions as the chosen ball - e.g. if the chosen ball lies on the fairway both players may play from the fairway. If in the rough, a bunker or penalty area both balls must be played from the same conditions.

The partner's ball must be dropped in the same conditions as the chosen ball within one (1) club length no nearer to the hole.

- 4. On the putting green the chosen ball must be marked. The other ball must be placed on the green within fifteen (15) cms. of the chosen ball. In the interest of pace of play the first player to putt may putt out.
- 5. These rules may be altered or amended at any time at the discretion of CCDGA Inc.
