Terms of the Competition

To be read in conjunction with the standard conditions for State events, the Rules of Golf and the local rules of Gosford and Wyong Golf Clubs.

Events in conjunction:

- Regional Championship
- Regional Junior Championship (Under 18 as at 10 August 2024)
- Regional Senior Championship (50 years and over as at 10 August 2024)
- Sandy Cameron Shield
- Jim Baker Shield

Eligibility:

Open to male amateur golfers who are bona fide residents outside the Sydney Metropolitan area and are members of a golf club affiliated within Region 2 which incorporates Central Coast, Hunter River, Lower North Coast and Newcastle District Golf Associations. Competitors may only play for 1 District team.

Field:

The field will be limited to 128 players. If necessary, a ballot based on GA handicaps will be conducted.

GA Handicap limit: 18

Format:

Day 1 – Gosford GC Registration from 11.00am / Shotgun start 12.00pm
Day 2 – Wyong GC Registration from 6.30am / Shotgun start 7.30am

The leading eight (8) players will be seeded after the first round.

Regional Championship, Junior Regional Championship and Senior Regional Championships.

36 hole stroke play – in the event of a tie for the Regional Championship, Junior and/or Masters Championship joint winners will be declared. All other ties will be decided using the Golf Australia count back system.

Sandy Cameron Shield.

Teams of four (4) players from the same Club.

Best three (3) scratch scores in each round to count – in the event of a tie the fourth (4th) score will count.

More than one (1) team from the same club may be entered however a competitor may only represent one Club and be a member of one team.

Entries must be submitted to the Match Committee prior to commencement of the event.

Jim Baker Shield

Each District will field a team comprising the following:

Eleven (11) Open players – best ten (10) scores to count.

Five (5) Junior (under 18) players – best four (4) scores to count

Five (5) Master (over 50) players – best four (4) scores to count.

Scores

Scores <u>MUST</u> be returned on the scorecard provided. Scores returned electronically will not be accepted.

Trophies

A junior (under 18 as at 10 August 2024) may win the Junior and the Regional Championship, all other players are eligible to win only one (1) trophy plus a team trophy:
