#### To be read in conjunction with the standard conditions for State events.

#### **Events in conjunction:**

#### **Eligibility:**

Open to male amateur golfers who are bona fide residents outside the Sydney Metropolitan area and are members of a country golf club affiliated within Region 2 which incorporates Central Coast, Hunter River, Lower North Coast & Newcastle District Golf Associations. Competitors may only play for 1 District team.

#### Field:

The field will be limited to 128 players. If necessary, a ballot based on GA handicap will be conducted.

Handicap limit: 18

#### Format:

Day 1 Registration from 11.30am / Shotgun start 12.30pm
Day 2 Registration from 7.30 am / Shotgun start 8.30 am

The leading 8 players (Gross scores) will be seeded after the first round

#### Regional Championship, Junior and Senior Regional Championships

36 hole stroke play – in the event of a tie for the Regional Championship, Junior & Masters Championship joint winners will be declared. All other ties will be decided using the Golf Australia count back system.

#### **Sandy Cameron Shield**

Teams of 4 players from the same club

Best 3 scratch scores in each round to count – in the event of a tie the 4th score will count

More than one team from the same club may be entered however a competitor may only represent one club and be a member of one team.

Entries must be submitted to the Match Committee prior to the commencement of the event

#### Jim Baker Shield

Each District will field a team comprising the following:

11 Open (18 and over) players – best 10 scores to count

5 Master (50 and over) players - best 4 scores to count

5 Junior (under 18 years) players - best 4 scores to count

#### **Scores**

#### **Trophies:**

A junior (under 18 as at 12 August 2023) may win the Junior and Regional Championship, all other players are eligible to win only one trophy plus a team trophy
